As the summer holidays approach, bringing to a close another academic year, we would like to once again thank all the students for their commitment and hard work over the past academic year. Now that we are well into the GCSE exam series, Year 11 will be going on study leave from today, Friday 10th June at 12.00p.m. This will give all students the opportunity to maximise their revision at home.

Revision resources can be found on both the school website and our VLE (Firefly). There are still a number of exams left for students to sit, it is important that your child still comes to school for their revision sessions before each exam. These sessions start at 8.40a.m for a morning exam, and during their normal period 3 for an afternoon exam. Students are also encouraged to attend school for science revision lessons on Tuesday 14th June between 12.20 and 3.00p.m in preparation for their GCSE the following day. Students will also be contacted individually if subjects require them in school for revision or completion of work in other subjects.

May I also take this opportunity to remind you of an important date. GCSE Examination Results Day will be on **Thursday 25th August 2022**. Pupils will be able to collect their results at the school's Sports Hall from 9.30am. Pupils who are returning to Aston Manor Academy 6th Form will also be required to enrol on this morning. If you are unable to collect your results in person, you may nominate someone to collect them on your behalf. You should email jmeeley@astonmanoracademy.com no later than 15th July with this request.

All students coming into school should be in full school uniform. Exams are conducted in very strict conditions and therefore we ask students not to wear shirts that may have been signed by other students. We will advise students that Monday 20th June will be a date set aside for students to collect signatures if they wish after the completion of the science exam.
